

Privacy Collection Notice

for Clinician Vaccine Integrated Platform

The Clinician Vaccine Integrated Platform (CVIP) is a tool developed to help your healthcare provider meet their mandatory reporting obligations under the Australian Immunisation Register Act 2015 (the Register Act) and to collect critical information (including personal and sensitive information, such as the main reason you were assessed as eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine) that supports government health agencies in implementing vaccination programs.

Any personal or sensitive information recorded by your vaccination provider in CVIP is protected under the Privacy Act 1988 and, where required by the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), the Register Act.

When you give the Australian Government Department of Health your personal information in CVIP, we use it for the following purposes:

- to verify your identity;
- to allow a healthcare provider treating you to view your AIR record including immunisation history;
- to report details of your vaccinations to AIR;
- to allow clinics to produce a list of vaccinations provided through the clinic; and
- to allow Commonwealth and State or Territory health agencies to monitor the progress of vaccinations.

If no matching record is located in AIR, a new record will be created. If you provide your consent, we may collect some personal information (including sensitive information) from you, including the main reason you were assessed as being eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. This is not reported to the AIR but will be used to support Commonwealth as well as State and Territory governments in the monitoring and clinical administration of vaccinations. If you do not provide your consent for us to record this information, you will still be able to receive your COVID-19 vaccination (and your vaccination details will still be reported to the AIR).

We will temporarily store your personal and sensitive information in CVIP using a secure cloud-based storage solution. After your vaccination details are reported to the AIR and/or your vaccination provider, these details will be deleted from CVIP; this usually occurs within 24 hours.

Commonwealth and State or Territory health agencies may receive and use your information (including, with your consent, the main reason you were assessed as eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine) to support us managing and monitoring implementation of the vaccine rollout. The Australian Digital Health Agency has been authorised to assist with this process through CVIP if necessary.
