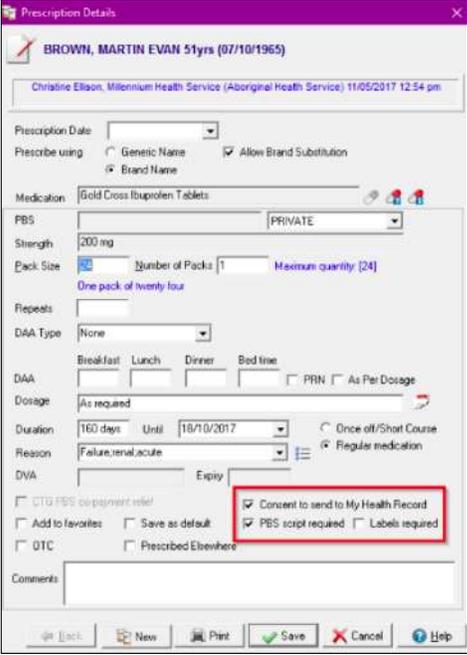


# Stop a prescription record being uploaded to My Health Record

**Note:** These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

<p><b>STEP 1:</b> Click on the <b>Prescribe Medication</b> icon at the top of the client file.</p>	
<p><b>STEP 2:</b> When prescribing a medication, to stop a prescription record being uploaded to My Health Record, untick the box titled <b>“Consent to send to My Health Record”</b> on the Prescription Details screen.</p>
