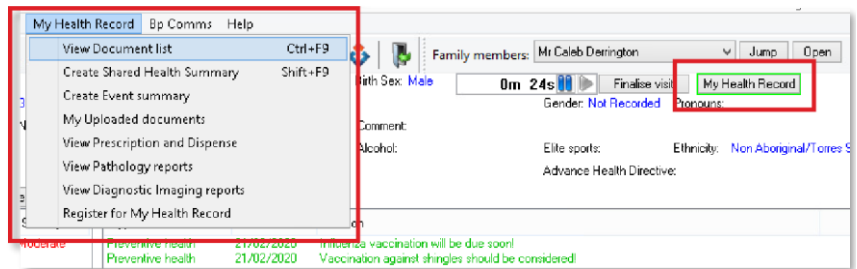




Accessing immunisation information

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system.

- To gain access to the patient's My Health Record, either:
 - select **My Health Record > View Document list** from the menus; or
 - click on the **My Health Record button**.



- Immunisation Consolidated View** appears within the document list. Double-click to open and view the document.

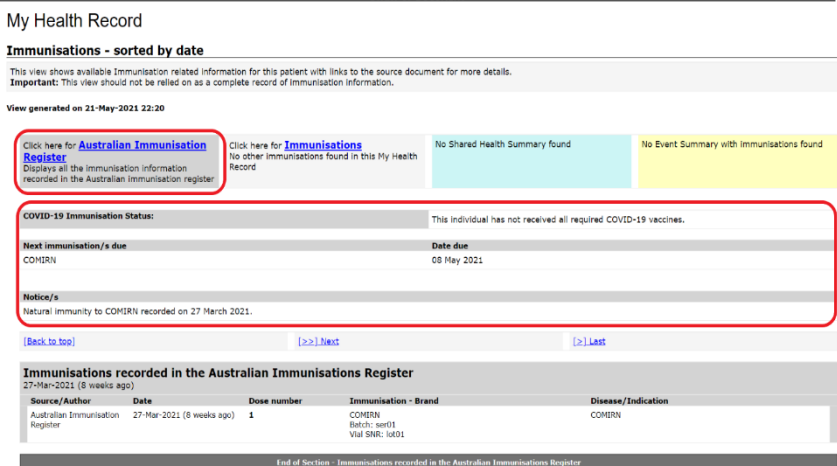


- The **Immunisation Consolidated View** will display with the **Australian Immunisation Register tab** displayed by default. Details of a patient's immunisation status including details of next immunisation(s) will also be displayed if recorded in AIR.



The COVID-19 Immunisation Status field displays as:

- 'This individual has **not** received all required COVID-19 vaccines.' if someone has had only one vaccine; or
- 'This individual has received all required COVID-19 vaccines.'



If no COVID-19 vaccines have been received, the status isn't displayed.

If there is additional information recorded in the AIR, this is displayed in a **Notices** section. This may include details about immunisation exemptions or participation in vaccine trials.

- Click on the **Immunisations** tab to access available immunisation information recorded in the Australian Immunisation Register and held in any shared health summaries or event summaries in a patient's My Health Record.

Note: You can click on any hyperlinks within the immunisations list to view the original source document.

The childhood version of the Australian Immunisation Register started in 1996, so younger people will have their childhood immunisations listed.
