

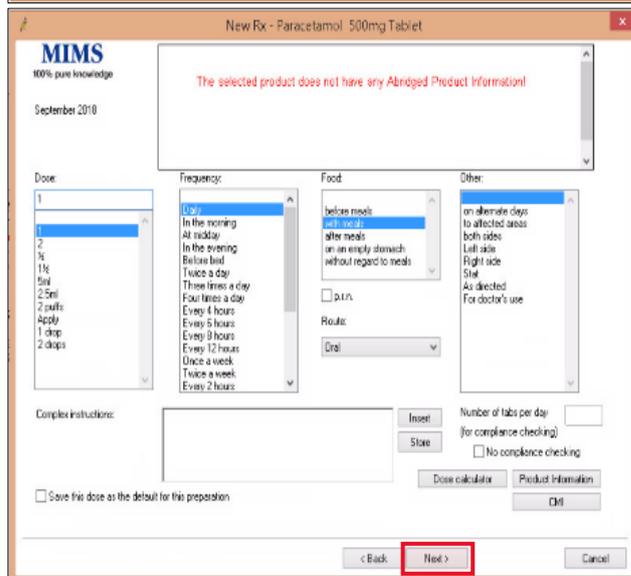
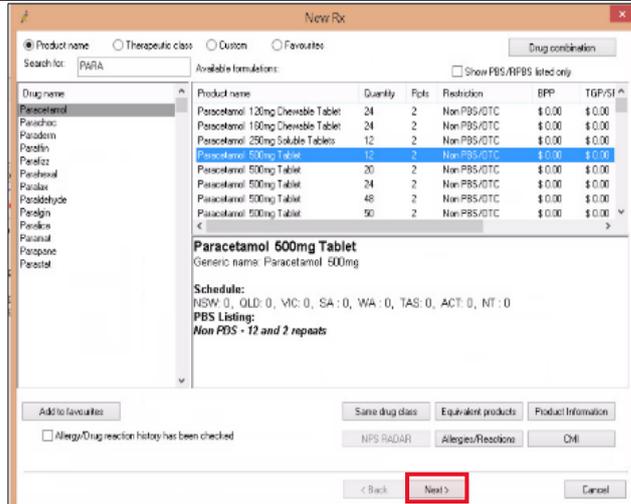
Stop a prescription record being uploaded to My Health Record

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

STEP 1:
Select **New Rx** from the top menu (top-left corner).



STEP 2:
Complete the next two prescribing screens.



Stop a prescription record being uploaded to My Health Record continued

STEP 3:

In the third prescribing screen, deselect **Upload to My Health Record via eRx**.
