




Accessing Advance Care Planning Information

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

<p>STEP 1: To access the patient's My Health Record, select My Health Record from the top menu.</p>	
<p>STEP 2: The patient document list will display. To find the information quickly, you can click on the sort arrow next to Document. The Advance Care Planning document will appear at the top of the list. Double-click to open and view the document.</p>	
<p>STEP 3: An Advance Care Plan/ Directive will display information related to a person's wishes for future medical treatment. It may also include the details of a custodian they have nominated to share this information with. Click on the hyperlink to view the document.</p>
