



# Accessing Advance Care Planning Information

*Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system*

<p><b>STEP 1:</b> To access the patient's My Health Record, select <b>My Health Record</b> from the top menu.</p>	
<p><b>STEP 2:</b> The patient document list will display. To find the information quickly, you can click on the sort arrow next to <b>Document</b>. The <b>Advance Care Planning</b> document will appear at the top of the list. Double-click to open and view the document.</p>	
<p><b>STEP 3:</b> An <b>Advance Care Plan/ Directive</b> will display information related to a person's wishes for future medical treatment. It may also include the details of a custodian they have nominated to share this information with. Click on the hyperlink to view the document.</p>
