Note:

Your patient may wish for certain diagnostic imaging reports not to be submitted to My Health Record. We encourage you to discuss this with your patient. This will not affect your current business process of requesting and receiving diagnostic imaging reports, it simply stops the information being sent to your patient's My Health Record.

1. In **Medical Imaging Requests**, tick **Do not send reports to My Health Record**.
