

# Uploading an Event Summary

*Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system*

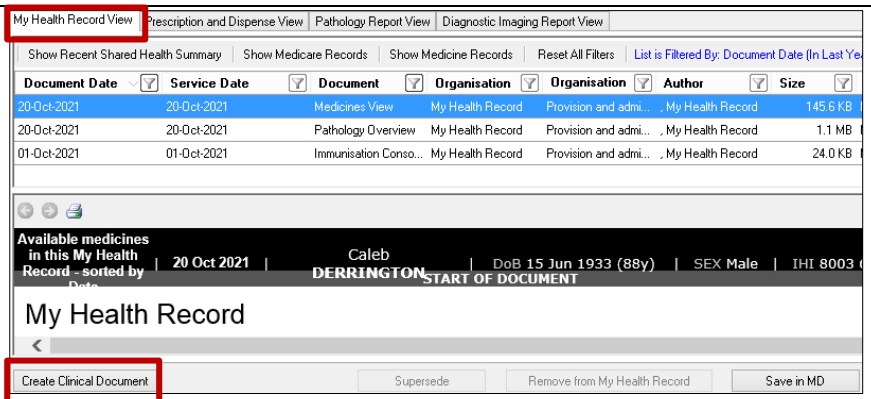
## STEP 1:

Once you have opened the patient's local medical record and entered the clinical information/notes for the consultation, select the **My Health Record** tab to gain access to the patient's My Health Record.



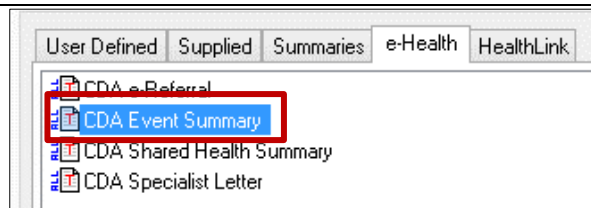
## STEP 2:

In the **My Health Record View** tab, select **Create Clinical Document** (bottom-left corner).



## STEP 3:

In the **e-Health** tab, double-click on **CDA Event Summary** or highlight it and select **OK**.



## Uploading an Event Summary continued

### STEP 4:

Select **Import Progress Notes** to populate the Clinical Synopsis box. The Synopsis can also be entered/edited manually.

Tick/untick the items to include/not include in the Event Summary, then select the **Send to My Health Record** icon (top-left corner).

By clicking on the **More** buttons you can also import information already saved in the patient's local medical record.

### STEP 5:

Review the Event Summary to verify it has populated correctly, then select **Send** (bottom-right corner).

### STEP 6:

A pop-up will appear confirming the Event Summary has been successfully uploaded. Select **OK**.

The Event Summary will also save to the patient's local medical record in the **Letters** tab. There will also be a new entry in the **Progress** tab.
