

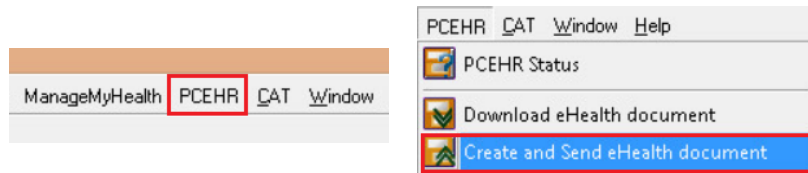


Uploading a Shared Health Summary

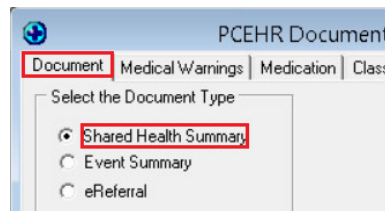
Note:

- a) These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient's Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system, and the patient has a My Health Record.
- b) My Health Record was previously known as the Personally Controlled Electronic Health Record (PCEHR). PCEHR still appears in Medtech software.
- c) Before you begin, ensure that the patient's clinical information in their local medical record is up to date.

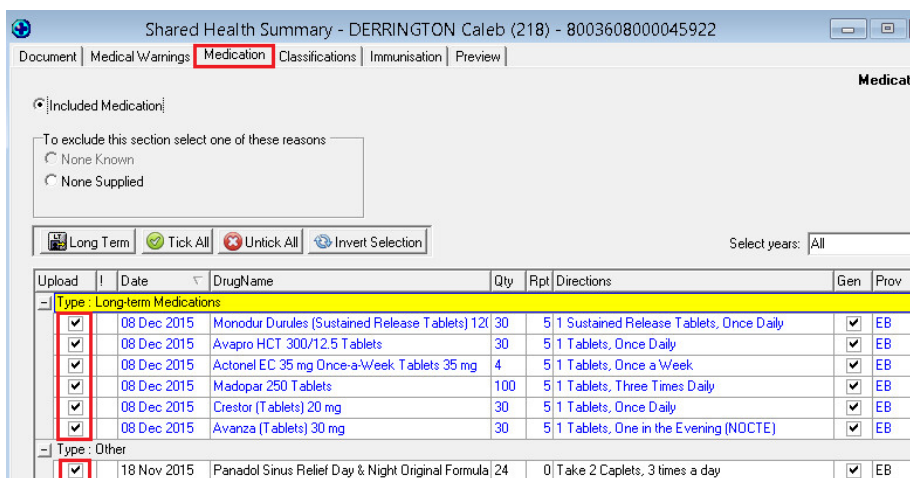
1. In the patient's local medical record, select the **PCEHR** tab, then select **Create and Send eHealth Document**.



2. In the **Document** tab, select **Shared Health Summary**.



3. The Shared Health Summary will auto-populate with information from the patient's local medical record.



Review the information in the **Medical Warnings**, **Medication**, **Classifications** and **Immunisation** tabs and tick/untick the items to include/not include in the Shared Health Summary.
