



THE **BIG** PICTURE








There are over **1.1 Billion**

CLINICAL DOCUMENTS


uploaded by a healthcare provider like hospitals, pathologists and increasingly specialists.

consumer documents 491K


uploaded by people.

Values are cumulative totals for the previous 13 months






How are healthcare professionals using these documents?

Documents uploaded which were viewed by other organisations












Volume of **clinical documents** uploaded






Volume of **pathology reports** uploaded




Volume of **discharge summaries** uploaded
