
Statistics and Insights OCTOBER 2022










There are over **784M**

CLINICAL DOCUMENTS


uploaded by a healthcare provider like hospitals, pathologists and radiologists.

258K people have registered for a My Health Record who had previously opted out or cancelled.





HOW ARE **PEOPLE** USING IT?

This month over **18K** people checked who had accessed their record.














How are healthcare professionals using these documents?
















Volume of medicine documents

Volume of **dispense records** uploaded









Volume of **pathology reports** uploaded
