Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

Accessing Immunisation Information continued

STEP 4:

The Immunisation Consolidated View will display with the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) tab displayed by default. Details of a patient's immunisations as recorded in AIR will be displayed here.

Information will include the date of vaccination, dose number, brand administered and disease/indication.

Next immunisation/s due will display if the patient is due for a vaccination.

If there is additional information recorded in the AIR, this is displayed in a **Notice/s** section. This may include details about immunisation exemptions.

A National Immunisation Program (NIP) Status may also display for patients receiving immunisations under the program with corresponding text to confirm if the patient is up to date with recommended vaccines.

STEP 5:

For additional information, click on the **Immunisations** tab to access available immunisation information recorded in the Australian Immunisation Register and held in any shared health summaries or event summaries in a patient's My Health Record.

You can click on any hyperlinks within the immunisations list to view the original source document.

From this view you can also access the most recent **shared health summary** and **event summary** that contain immunisation information.
