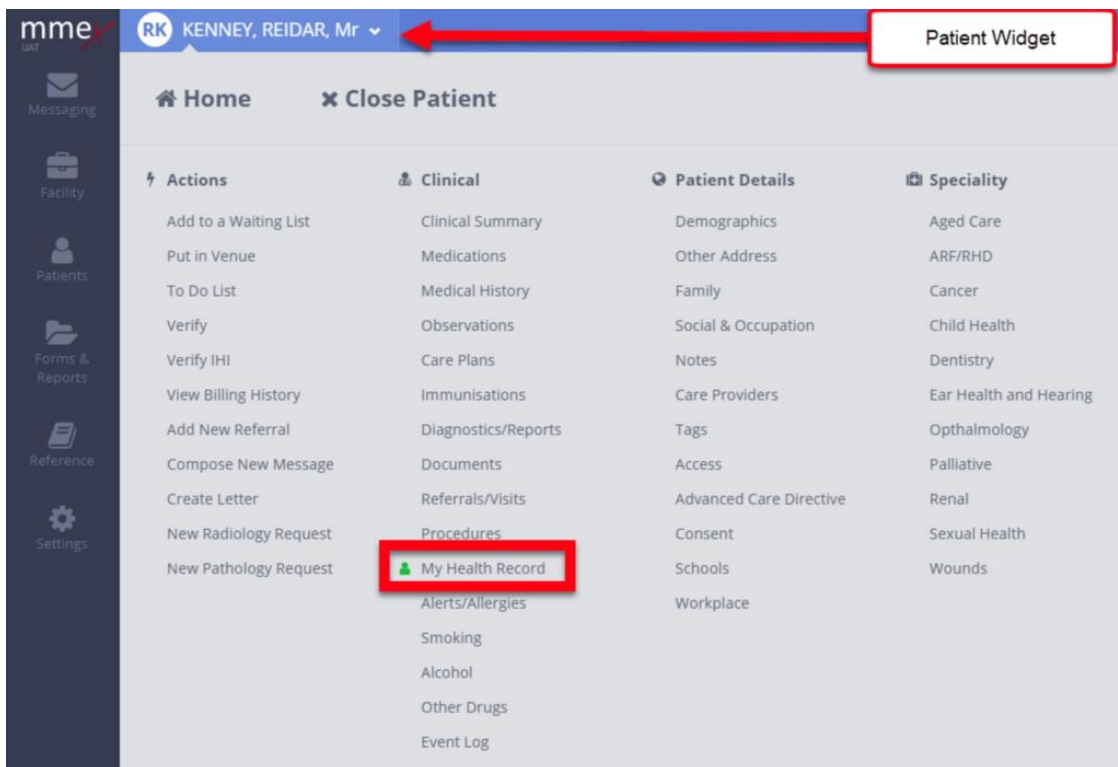


Viewing Clinical Documents

Note:

These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, your patient's Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system, and they have a My Health Record.

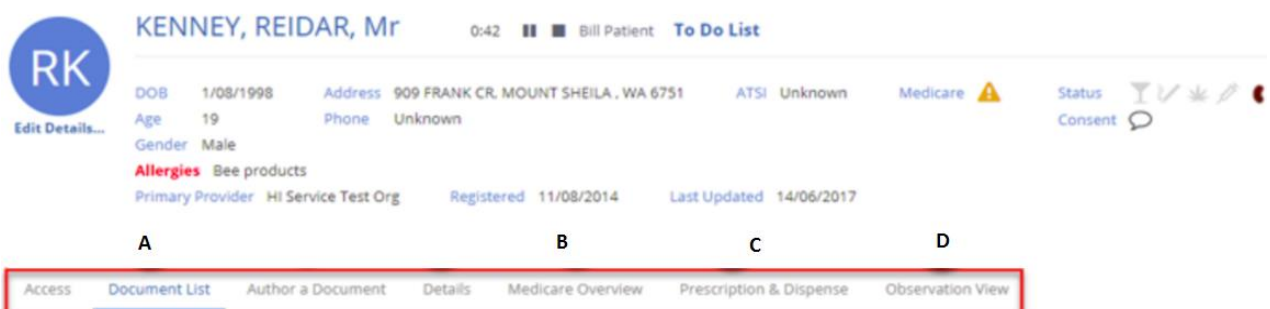
1. Select the patient widget (top-left corner), then select **My Health Record**.



2. Patient information can be viewed as:

- a. **Document List** - List of clinical documents that exist in your patient's My Health Record. See screenshot below.
- b. **Medicare Overview** – This includes information of Medicare claims, PBS claims, immunisations (AIR), and organ donor status.
- c. **Prescription & Dispense** – Shows your patient's medication history and status.
- d. **Observation View** - Where observation data exists, it will be available to view. This includes information entered by your patient, or by their providers.

Each section has filters to make finding information easier.

3. In the **Document List** section, select **View** to open an individual clinical document.

- Adverse reactions
- Medications
- Medical History
- Immunisations
