

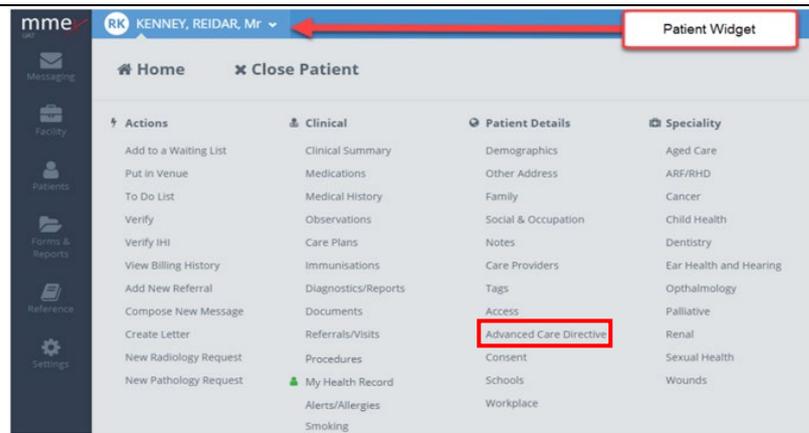
# Uploading Advanced Care Directives in My Health Record

*Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system.*

**STEP 1:**

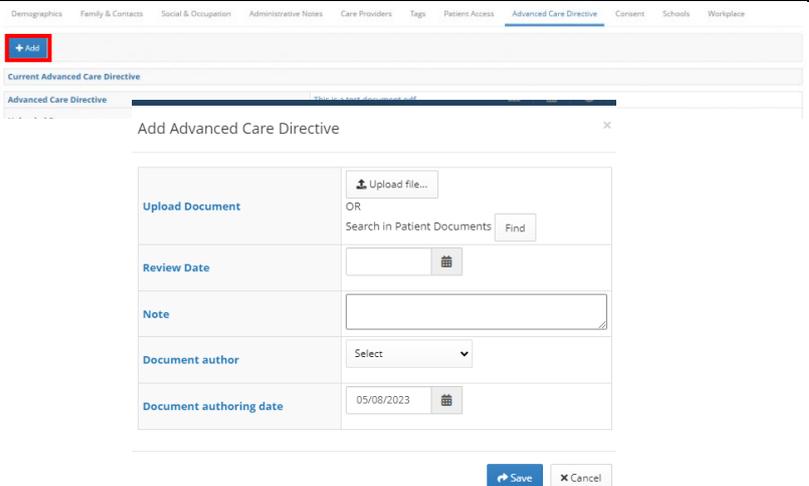
To add an Advanced Care Directive (ACD), select the patient widget.

Then select **'Advanced Care Directive'** under **'Patient Details'**



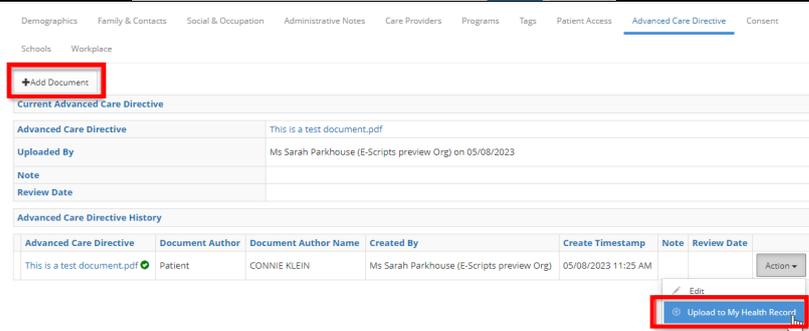
**STEP 1:**

Click **'+Add'** to add a new Advanced Care Planning document to the tab, so it can be uploaded. The pop up will display several fields of information that describe when the document was created and by whom as well as a review date. Additional fields will display depending on the document author type selected. This information is required to be recorded so that it is conformant for My Health Record

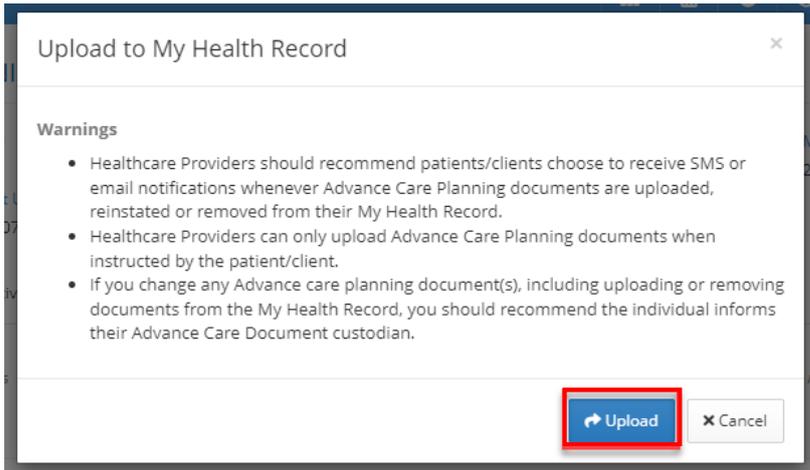
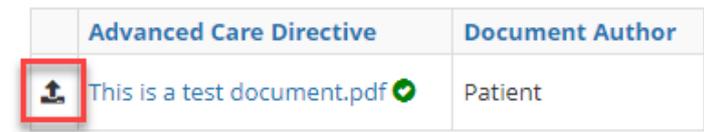
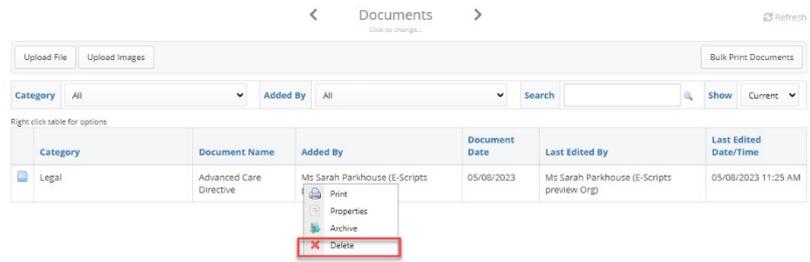


**STEP 2:**

The document will be added to the **'Advanced Care Directive History'** table, with an option to Upload the Document to My Health Record on the action menu.



## Uploading Advanced Care Directives in My Health Record continued

<p><b>STEP 4:</b> Once you have clicked the <b>'Upload Document to My Health Record'</b> button a pop up will appear.</p> <p>Click <b>Upload</b>.</p>	
<p><b>STEP 5:</b> Once uploaded you will see an icon that indicates a successful upload.</p>	
<p><b>Removing Advanced Care Directives</b></p>	
<p>To remove an Advanced Care Planning document, you will need to delete it from the patient record <b>'Documents List'</b>. <i>(Not all users have the ability to delete a document so you may need to speak with a Senior Clinician or Organisation Administrator to do this on your behalf)</i></p> <p>When deleted, the information will be removed from the Advanced Care Planning Tab.</p> <p><i>Please note: Any documents uploaded to MHR will not be deleted by deleting the document from the MMEx record.</i></p>
