

Accessing Pathology Reports

Note:

These steps assume that you have an individual PRODA account, your HPI-I has been linked to your organisation's HPI-O and the patient has a My Health Record.

Step 1

Open the National Provider Portal and search for an individual by entering their:

- Last name
- Date of birth
- Sex
- A unique numeric identifier, either their Medicare or DVA number, or their Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI).
