



# Accessing the Medicare Overview


*Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system*

<p><b>STEP 1:</b> To access the patient's My Health Record, select the green 'e' My Health Record icon above the Summary Views panel</p>	
<p><b>STEP 2:</b> The My Health Record Documents screen will appear with the Clinical Documents tab displayed by default. This shows the list of recent documents in the patient's My Health Record.</p> <p>You can filter the list by document type by selecting the <b>Filter by</b> button then click to expand <b>Medicare Documents</b>. Tick the relevant document types then click <b>OK</b>. Click <b>Refresh</b> to apply the new filters.</p>	

## Accessing the Medicare Overview continued

**STEP 3:**

Select the **Medicare Overview** document you wish to view and double click **View Document**.




**STEP 4:**

Scroll through to find information related to:

- Prescription Information
- Australian Immunisation Register
- Australian Organ Donor Register

Medicare Services- MBS and DVA Items



**Note:** An individual can choose which Medicare information is added to their record. They can control information such as claims for medical services, doctor visits, tests, medicines, organ donation decisions, and immunisations. The individual can choose to add some or all of this information to their My Health Record.
