


Accessing Advance Care Planning Information

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

<p>STEP 1:</p> <p>To access the patient's My Health Record, select the green 'e' My Health Record folder icon above the Summary Views panel.</p>	
<p>STEP 2:</p> <p>The My Health Record Documents screen will display with the Clinical Documents tab selected by default. Click the Filter by button to show the list of documents in the patient's My Health Record.</p>	
<p>STEP 3:</p> <p>Click on the plus symbol to expand the Personal Documents list, then select Advance Care Information and click OK. Click Refresh to update your search (subject to any date filters you have also set).</p>	
<p>STEP 4:</p> <p>Click the plus symbol to expand the Advance Care Information documents within the list. Next, click on the document you would like to open. This will display the document in the bottom half of the screen. Click on View Document to expand to the full view.</p>	

STEP 5:

An **Advance Care Plan/ Directive** will display information related to a person's wishes for future medical treatment. It may also include the details of a custodian they have nominated to share this information with. Click on the hyperlink to view the document.
