



View Pathology and Diagnostic Imaging (DI) Reports Overviews

The Pathology Reports and Diagnostic Imaging Reports Overviews bring together all test reports available in a My Health Record within a specified date range, with tests grouped by date, name and type. These Overviews allow you to quickly and easily find a specific report.

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system.

- To access the patient's My Health Record, select the **My Health Record** icon above the **Summary Views** panel.

5. If you **cannot see** a Pathology/DI report within an Overview, please note the following:
- An overview will only show reports within the date range filter in the Document list.
 - If you don't select a date range, you will automatically see up to two years' worth of pathology reports and seven years' worth of DI reports.
 - If your date range is too narrow, try expanding the date range in the Document list.

Other reasons why you may not see a report:

- Report links may be missing if there are too many reports for the system to display within your set date range, or if the report itself is too large. If this is the case, instructions will be provided to guide you to open the report.
- The reports may not have been uploaded to the patient's My Health Record.
- The reports may have been restricted from view by the patient or their representative.
